

## Freeman Uniform Policy

School uniforms will be worn by students. Students are expected to adhere to certain standards of cleanliness and dress that are compatible with the requirements of a productive and safe school environment. Teachers should refer students with uniform needs to the school social worker or school counselor.

### Uniformed Dress Guidelines •

Shirt must have sleeves and collar.

- Shirt may be any solid color. (Stripes, plaids, images, and decorations will not be allowed)
- Shirt may have a Rachel Freeman logo on front. (Brand names or other logos will not be permitted.)
- Shirt must be tucked inside student's pants/skirts/shorts/etc.
- Turtleneck is acceptable.
- Sweaters/sweatshirts must be free of labels and graphics,(Rachel Freeman logo will be accepted. Brand names or other logos will not be permitted.)
- The Sweater/sweatshirt jacket or any jacket kept on in the classroom must be a solid color as well.
- Pants, skirts, skorts and shorts must be tan, khaki, navy or black (No Denim)
- Shorts/Skirts/Skorts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.
- Uniform Jumper Dresses, acceptable (solid color).
- Shoes must have no open backs, spike heels, or be flip flops or Heelies shoes.

If your child arrives at school out of uniform, please expect the following:

#### 1. 1st Offense

Parent contact will be made by the teacher to inform of the dress code violation.

#### 2. 2nd Offense

Parents will be called to bring the appropriate clothing for their child. If parents are unable to assist, the student may be loaned clothing from the Freeman closet, if available.

#### 3. 3rd Offense

Parents will be called to bring the appropriate clothing for their child. The student will be removed from their classroom until the appropriate clothing is provided by their parent.
