

NHCS Governor's School Timeline for Students and Families 2018-2019

The Governor's School of North Carolina is a five and one-half week summer residential program for intellectually gifted and talented high school students in the nation. The program, **is open to rising seniors only, with the exceptions made for rising juniors in selected performing/visual arts areas.** Click on the link below or visit www.ncgovschool.org for more information and access to the student application.

Due to school cancellations NHCS will follow the timeline below:

October 30th: Informational session presented by the director of Governor's School at Hoggard High, starting at 6:00 p.m.

October 15th-November 2nd: Student application window for Governor's School.

November 2nd: School deadline for student applications for Governor's School. Students must submit completed application by 3:00 pm to GS school contact. Each student should complete the NHCS Governor's School Application Cover Form at a prior to submission.

November 14th: Schools submit nominees to district

December 14th: NHCS Governor's School academic and arts nominees will be submitted the state selection committee by the district.

By December 19th: All students will be notified by mail or their status by the district

February 2019: Governor School auditions in Art, Choral Music, Dance, Instrumental Music, and Theater, Dates, and locations will be determined by Governor's School.

Audition Dates – The generous staff at Meredith College in Raleigh have agreed to host auditions again this year for Governor's School nominees in the five art disciplines. With that their campus availability is limited, requiring movement of the auditions in Instrumental Music and Choral Music from the usual February dates to January. Here is the confirmed schedule:

- Saturday, January 19 – Auditions in Choral Music and Instrumental Music
- Saturday, February 9 – Auditions in Visual Art, Theater and Dance
- General audition details are already in the Nomination Packet, available for download from the website. Specific details (e.g., times, locations, preparations, etc.) will be sent to individual nominees in the late fall

March 8: Letters of selection/non-selection will be mailed to students from Governor's School
